Note: When using \$true or \$false in PowerShell, you can think of \$true as meaning "on" and \$false as meaning "off".

```
Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy" -MeetingChatEnabledType Enabled
```

Microsoft Team Admin Center option	PowerShell
On for everyone	Enabled
On for everyone but anonymous users	EnabledExceptAnonymous
Off	Disabled

```
Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy" -AllowExternalNonTrustedMeetingChat $true
```

Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy" -QnAEngagementMode $true
```
