## Errata

### “Declaring and Initializing Arrays”

The code examples in this video show the declaration of `days_in_year` as follows:

```
const double days_in_year {365};
```

This is incorrect. The type of `days_in_year` should be `int` since it is being used to declare the size of the array `hi_temperatures`.

The correct declaration should be:

```
const int days_in_year {365};
```
