

## Beginning C++ Programming C++ Strings

In the second slide in this video (at about 2:20) there is a typo in the example for `s5` -- there is a mismatched parenthesis and curly brace.

The correct line should read:

```
String s5 {"Frank", 3};  
  or  
String s5 ("Frank", 3);
```
