File Locations with some Popular IDEs

CodeLite Update

In recent versions of CodeLite, the location of the files has changed. Previously, you would need to go up one level in the folder structure using something like:

```
"../filename.txt"
```

In the newer versions of CodeLite, you should place your text files in the same folder as your main.cpp file and use the following:

```
"filename.txt"
```

Using files in Visual Studio Code.

If you set up Visual Studio Code as I do in the “**Bonus Section – Using Visual Studio Code**”, then you need to place your text files in the same folder as main.cpp. Then when you open the file in C++, you can use:

```
"filename.txt"
```
