
Dockerfile Basics

Docker : Build Docker Images

- Docker can build images automatically by reading the instructions from a **Dockerfile**.
- A **Dockerfile** is a text document that contains all the commands a user could call on the command line to assemble an image.
- A Docker image consists of read-only layers each of which represents a **Dockerfile** instruction.
- Command to build image from Dockerfile:
docker build -f <path_of_docker_file>
